Requirements

- Both BAH Majors and Medials:
 - Minimum cumulative GPA = 1.9
- Majors (APEC/ECON):
 - Completion of ECON 310, 320*, 351
 - 30 units of ECON with minimum GPA = 2.6

*Recommended but not required for APEC students
- Medials:
 - Completion of ECON 310 or 320 or 351
 - 18 units of ECON with minimum GPA = 2.6
 - Eligible for final year in second concentration
