Western Union Global Scholars

WU Global Scholars is a scholarship program established by the Western Union Foundation to support international students in the final or penultimate year of their Bachelor's degree program experiencing financial hardship that may prevent the completion of their studies.

Selected scholars will receive up to \$10,000 USD for the 2024-25 academic year, based on the cost of tuition and fees and their demonstrated financial need.

To be considered, nominated students must:

- Be an international student (a student who is neither a citizen nor permanent resident of the country in which they are studying) in their penultimate (expected graduation in 2026) or final year of studies (expected graduation in 2025).
- Be studying in an accredited post-secondary higher education institution in: Australia or New Zealand; Japan or Singapore; the U.S. or Canada; the United Kingdom; or Europe.
- Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate (Bachelor's) degree program for Academic Year 2024-2025 or a corresponding timeframe for universities with other semester systems.

All nominations are submitted by faculty. You cannot nominate yourself. If you are interested in being nominated, please contact our Undergraduate Chair, Mike Barber, at econ.ugrad.chair@queensu.ca by April 8th.
