


Important Dates

A poster session that showcases undergraduate student research will take place during the <u>56th Annual</u> <u>Meeting of the Canadian Economics Association</u> (CEA). Current undergraduate students registered at a Canadian university, or those who have graduated in the past year but have not yet begun their graduate studies, are encouraged to apply. High-quality original research papers, in either French or English, in any area of Economics will be considered.

Up to 10 students will be invited to present their research at the conference. The successful candidates should prepare to present their work in a poster session to a select group of evaluators. Due to the

evolving nature of the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, the precise format of the presentation (online, hybrid or virtual only) will be determined closer to the dates of the conference.

Cash prizes of \$500 CAD each for the Best Poster Presentation and the Best Paper will be awarded.

The submission deadline is April 22, 2022 23:59 EST.
