"Mortgage Rates and Monetary Policy Over the Business Cycle" with Hongfei Sun (Job Market Paper)

Abstract: We study the responses of mortgage rates to monetary policy over the business cycle. Using loan-level data from Fannie Mae we first document a significant change in the relationship between the policy rate and mortgage rates following a regulatory change by the Federal Reserve on the interest rate it pays banks for maintaining excess reserve. Our evidence suggests that the business cycle had little effect on the transmission of monetary policy into mortgage rates before the regulatory change, but a strong effect after the change. To understand this phenomenon, we construct a theoretical model of oligopolistic banks, who are subject to monetary policy through the adjustments of the policy rate and the reserves' requirements. With this model, we show that the documented shift in the policy effects could have been due to the regulatory change by the Federal Reserve.
